



FREE MEALS DELIVERED TO BUS STOPS DURING REMOTE LEARNING

Dear Parents/Guardians, Students & Staff:

In an effort to ensure continuity of nutrition during remote learning, the Keystone School District is offering FREE meals delivered to your child(ren)'s bus stop. School buses will run regular afternoon bus routes on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays during remote learning. Meal delivery should be expected around the same time your child generally returns home from school in the afternoon. A few important steps/notes that must be followed and considered in order to receive FREE meal service at your bus stop:

1. **All students in grades K-12 are eligible for FREE meal service.**
2. Complete the "Meal Delivery Survey" link on the building-level websites. Only one survey must be completed per family. You may also call your respective school office and request that your name be added to our meal delivery service list.
3. A parent/guardian, caregiver or student must be present at the bus stop in order to take receipt of the meals being delivered.
4. Meals will be delivered on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays during remote learning. Multiple meals will be included with each delivery to ensure breakfasts and lunches are available to students on non-delivery days.
5. Drive-thru meal service will still remain available at Keystone Elementary School on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM for as long as families choose the drive-thru service option.

MEAL DELIVERY LOCATION & TIME

Meals will be delivered on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays to your regular afternoon bus stop around drop-off time. Someone must be present at the stop to take receipt of the meals. Meal delivery service begins on Friday, December 4th.
