Pre-Game Meals: Kate Siegel has her committee and is ready to start.

Post-Game Meals: Wendy Greenawalt had to step down as chairperson, due to Layton's injury. Mary Rearick consented to do a trial post game meal for the scrimmage this Friday, with Wendy and her committee's help. Depending on how it goes, Mary will let us know if she will take over the chairperson position.

Spirit Ads deadline was 8/24/09, so Marcy Hurst could get them sent in to Identity Studios in time for the program printing.

Fence Business Signs: 12 signs sold so far, Marcy Hurst was informed by Vinyl Graphics that the signs will be done and ready to be put up before school starts.

Business Ads: Marcy stated that they are doing well; they are almost all completed and ready for the program.

Meet the Player's: Has been changed to **Tuesday September 1st at 6:30 PM.** due to the Jr. High scrimmage on Weds. It will be on the track if the weather is nice or in the gym if it is raining. **All football families, Jr. High, JV and Varsity** are asked to bring in a dessert (cake, brownies, pie, cookies etc...) to the concession stand, or the cafeteria (depending on the weather.) A \$1 donation will be asked for at the gate/door for all spectators. A ticket will be given for that donation which then may be exchanged for a dessert after Meet the Player's. Refrigerators: At the last meeting we were informed that we had a refrigerator quit working in the concession stand. We had voted to pay half with KMA to purchase a new one. Stacy Thompson (KMA) later discovered that in fact 2 had quit working. Motion #1, 8/24/09:

Motion made by Rhonda Hannold and 2nd by Kelly Stiglitz to place the Jennifer Whisner ad in the program again this year. Ms. Whisner has placed a full page black & white ad in the program for years; she has not yet returned from Florida and has not been able to give her consent for this year's ad. It has been felt by those present, who know her that she would want the ad placed. If we do not put the ad in now, we will not be able to put it in later, due to layout spacing. Mike Lencer noted that if Ms. Whisner did not want, or did not pay for the ad, the boosters would cover the bill. All Present were in favor none opposed.

Jr. High Parents Meeting

During last week's Jr. High Parents meeting there were apparently some children playing on the football field. This was noticed by a few School Board Members, the Coaching Staff was informed, by these members that no one is to be on the field, except during the game. Mike Lencer asked to see the Field Use Policy and was informed that there is no such policy on record. Mrs. Walters intends to go to the next Athletic Council meeting to insure that there will be no future issues with the use of the football field. If we continue to have problems, we may need some parents to go to a School Board Meeting to address the situation.

NFL Tickets:

Jr High Parents were the first to receive the tickets to sell, because Varsity had first chance to sell the coaches Choice Cards, (so they could raise money for camp.) The tickets are \$10 each, the first 150 tickets sold = \$1500 which goes for the prize money pay out.

Motion made by Marcy Hurst and seconded by Shanelle Shick to accept tracking pay out as stated above. All present were in favor, none opposed.

Note: The tracking profits from this fundraiser will not be available until the sale has ended! Also be aware that this is a raffle and that the sellers must be at least 18 years old. So the parents must be the sellers and not the underage players!

Coach Nellis has 13 white Under Armor football socks; he would like the Boosters to purchase more, so that the Varsity team will match at the games. Most of the Mothers at the meeting did not want white socks (too hard to keep white); they recommended black or black and gold. This was tabled until the parents meeting, when coach will be present.

Each year the boosters buy the coaching staff shirts for the games. Coach Nellis gave Mike Lencer a sample of a yellow gold Under Armor shirt that the coaches wanted for this year. This was also tabled until

the parents meeting, when coach will be present. Missy Colwell stated that she thinks that the Jr. High Coaches had a different shirt picked out for their choice.

Farmers National Bank:

Farmers National Bank Manager, AJ Johnson mentioned to Mike Lencer that they would like to hand out vouchers, compliments of Farmers for a free coffee or hot chocolate at the football games. This would be advertising for them, and the bank would make a donation to the concession stand to cover the vouchers.

Foot Ball Toss:

It was suggested that the 9th Grade Boys be in charge of the Football Toss **before** the Varsity Home football games. Shanelle Shick volunteered to be in charge of getting parents to help run the game toss and collect the money.

Booster Credits: John Hannold was in charge of the Wedgie Sales, Mike Lencer was in charge of the Coaches Choice Cards, Kate Siegel is in charge of the Shirt sale, Steve Sayers and Scot Henry are in charge of the NFL Tickets and Shanelle Shick is in charge of the Football Toss Game. Each person will receive 10 Booster Credits into their player's tracking account for taking on these duties.

Homecoming:

Parade and bonfire are September 16th; both Jr. High and Varsity players will participate.

Game is Friday September 18th.

Dance is September 19th.
