Pres. Ron Best opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Jeanette Johns read the minutes from June meeting. There were no corrections or additions. Minutes were approved as read.

Tammy Evans read the treasurer's report. The balance in checking is \$7,783.27. This amount includes camp deposits and individual tracking. The general account balance is approx. \$3,000.00.

Deb Graham will be asked to send Ida-Vending a Thank you card for helping us.

There was a discussion about getting a slushie machine. Some of the concerns were taking away from pop sales, the added mess in the gymnasium; cost of cups, lids, etc. The discussion was tabled until more information is gathered.

Candles – Deb Graham will contact Janet to see if she is interested in doing the candle sale again this fall.

Car Wash

Raffle – There was discussion about raffling off lawn furniture, grill, etc. as was done in previous years. The ticket would cost the amount of the ticket

number. For example, if the ticket number were 001, then the cost of the ticket would be .01. If the ticket number were 500, then the cost would be \$5.00. The drawing will be the Saturday of Horsethief week. There was discussion about the amount to be spent on the items for raffle. The amount of \$500.00 total was decided on. Jeanne Shay made the motion to spend up to \$500.00 on the raffle items. Jesse Spicher 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor.

Tammy Evans and Jeanette Johns will do the shopping for the raffle items.

Only parents can sell the raffle tickets.

The tickets are usually donated once a year.

Profit will go into the general fund.

When you turn in the money for the tickets, do not turn in cash. Make one check payable to Keystone Cheerleading Boosters.

All fundraising money turned in should be in one check, not cash.

#### Lanyards & Dog Tags

It was suggested to sell lanyards and dog tags during football season and Horsethief. Coach Kami will order approx. 100 of each of these so we can sell them.

#### Horsethief week

Tina Wike checked with Ruby about T-shirts. Ruby has a sample for us to see. It is pigment dyed, distressed in black/gold. They will be available in short sleeve, long sleeve, and hoodies.

We can set up a stand on Fri. and Sat., Aug. 24,25. There is no charge for setting up a stand on Saturday. If the stand is on the street on Saturday, it needs to be torn down by 4:30 p.m. for the parade. Ron would like to have us set up beside the other food vendors.

There was a discussion about what to sell at the stand. It was decided to sell T-shirts, lanyards and dog tags, umbrellas, clings, soft drinks (pepsi products), water, propel, popcorn, nachos,. Taco in a bag, glow necklaces (Fri. night), and face painting.

Umbrellas need to be ordered so there are some on hand to sell. Tammy made a motion to order 24 more umbrellas, Jeannette Johns 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Deb Graham will order 24 more umbrellas.

### Glow necklaces

Last year the boosters spent \$50.00 for glow necklaces and made a profit of \$300.00. It was discussed that the necklaces can be sold Thurs. evening during the power wheels street ride as well as Friday evening, during the teen dance. It was discussed to purchase \$100.00 worth of glow necklaces.

Everyone was in favor for the decisions concerning Horsethief week.

Jeanne Shay thanked Rosie Best, Tammy Evans, Deb and Jayme Graham for their help with the pizza orders.

There were some parents that contacted Jesse Spicher and Deb Graham about not getting information concerning fundraising delivery and collection information.
