

June Meeting June 4, 2007

Pres. Ron Best opened the meeting at approx. 6:30 p.m. at Keystone High School in the choir room.

Secretary's report

Deb Graham read the minutes from the May meeting. There was one addition to the minutes. At the May meeting, Dottie Whitmer made the suggestion that even though the Jr. High cheerleaders are not required to go to cheer camp, they should be strongly encouraged to do so. She stated that it builds a strong foundation for the girls for future years and helps with team bonding.

Treasurer's report

Tammy Evans stated there were no changes to the treasurer's report.

Audit

There was an audit on the treasurer's books. Jeanne Best and Brenda Blair completed the audit on May 21, 2007. The books were also balanced with the check register on May 31, 2007. Jeanne stated that the books were in good order but had the following suggestions:

1. The treasurer should follow procedure for getting the proper signatures on the check request forms. Some of the forms did not have the required signatures.
2. Use an itemized form for start up money that is used for the concession stands competitions, etc.

Concession Machines

There was a discussion on the floor about the purchase of a pretzel and nacho warmer. These machines have been loaned to the Boosters in the past. It was discussed that the Boosters would not be comfortable asking to use them again this year because the people involved are no longer members of the cheerleaders or Boosters. Tammy Evans made the motion to purchase a pretzel and nacho warmer. Jeanette Johns 2nd the motion. All were in favor of purchasing the machines. Tammy Evans contacted Ida Vending about the purchase of these machines. She said the cost would be approx. \$700 to \$800. Kathy from Ida Vending is also checking on the availability and cost of refurbished machines. She will call Tammy with the information. Jeanne Best made the suggestion to look on-line to see if there are any machines for sale on E-Bay. Anyone wishing to research for information on E-Bay can bring the information to the next meeting.

Toaster Oven

Tammy Evans has donated a toaster oven to the Boosters for use in the concession stand. This will give the boosters 2 ovens to use. Coach Griglak donated one to the boosters last year.

4th of July

There was a discussion on the floor about having a food concession on the 4th of July in Clarion at the stadium. The boosters have done this in the past. Last year, the boosters made a profit of \$285.26. There was a discussion about whether there would be enough people available to work the stand. Jesse Spicher made the motion not to do the concession on July 4th. Deb Zerbe 2nd the motion. All were in favor. The boosters will not have a concession on the 4th of July.

It was voted on and accepted at the May meeting that the cheerleader boosters would help with the cost of the scrapbooks.

Coach Coursen contacted Lynn from Rogers Gym in Oil City. Since their facilities were closing, Lynn agreed to come to Keystone to instruct tumbling classes. Starting next week, Lynn will be here on Tues. and Wed. evening to instruct tumbling. The cost is \$30.00 for the rest of the month. Times are: beginner 5-6:30, intermediate/advanced 6:30 – 8:00. The inter/adv. class is for the cheerleaders who can do a standing back handspring or are very close. The classes will be held in the wrestling room. The cheerleaders can bring their money (\$30.00) to the first class on June 12.
