Policy for Using Sustained Silent Reading (SSR) Time

1. ALL students must read for the entire allotted reading period. NO EXCEPTIONS!
2. ALL teachers must read for the entire allotted reading period.
3. Students cannot do homework or read any material for another course. SSR is not a study hall. Assigned novels will be permitted.
4. Students can read a book, professional journal, magazine, newspaper, or manual. Magazines must be from the approved list.
5. Students must have something to read in their possession when SSR times starts; this is the main responsibility involved in coming prepared to class.
6. Students may not talk or disturb others. NO EXCEPTIONS!
7. Students should not ask to leave the room during SSR time. It disturbs others. Only administrative passes will be accepted.

****Failure to adhere to any SSR guideline will result in a disciplinary referral.**

****The SSR policies and discipline system will be consistently enforced in all classrooms.**
